

# EARLY INTERVENTION IMPROVES THE OUTCOME FOR YOUR CHILD

"A good early intervention program has at least four benefits:

- \* It will provide your child with instruction that will build on his or her strengths to teach new skills, improve behaviors, and remediate areas of weakness.
- \* It will help provide you with information that will help you better understand your child's behavior and needs.
- \* It will offer resources, support, and training that will enable you to work and play with your child more effectively.
- \* It will improve the outcome for your child.

For these reasons, an intervention program for your child should be implemented as soon as possible after he or she receives a diagnosis."

# EARLY INTERVENTION FOR THE YOUNG CHILD

Bright Beginnings is an Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) based program for children with developmental disabilities. ABA is a scientifically proven intervention approach which uses principles that increase skills and decrease challenging behavior by using positive reinforcement strategies.

Our approach is individualized and incorporates the family's goals for their child. We build on the child's strengths and interests and use both structured and natural opportunities to facilitate learning.

## QUALIFICATIONS

Children diagnosed with Autism and other developmental disabilities ages 3 through kindergarten are eligible for this program.

Bright Beginnings uses funding through Idaho Children's Developmental Disabilities Habilitation Intervention Services or you may pay privately.



Bright Beginnings builds foundational skills in communication, play, social interaction, daily living tasks, and learning readiness to pave a path for success in school, community, and at home

## WHO PROVIDES SERVICES?

A Board Certified Analyst (BCBA) guides treatment for your child. Therapists working with children in this program are certified Intervention Specialists and receive additional training in ABA.

## ENROLLMENT

Applications are accepted year round as spots are available. An application fee of \$50 is due with the application. Space is limited to a maximum of 12 children per year.

## PROGRAM DETAILS

- \* Groups of up to six children work one on one with highly trained Intervention Specialists on individualized goals (based on formal assessment).
- \* Morning (8:30 - 11:30 AM) and afternoon (12:00 - 3:00 PM) sessions are offered Monday - Thursday.
- \* The program runs year round.
- \* The program includes family collaboration in the home on Fridays.
- \* Family Education classes are offered quarterly.
