HELPING INDIVIDUALS MEET THEIR GOALS

The employment department at RISE serves individuals of working age. Services are individualized and provided by our professional staff to assist individuals in reaching their vocational goals leading to long term employment success.



PROGRAM FUNDING

Services are provided in conjunction with the Idaho Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, the Idaho Commission for the Blind & Visually Impaired, Idaho Department of Health and Welfare, Montana State University (WIPA), and employers throughout Idaho. Consumer Direct Services and Private Pay are also funding options.

PRE-EMPLOYMENT TRANSITION SERVICES

This service is geared toward high school students (ages 16-21) with disabilities.

"Creating Opportunities For and With People"

Students who participate in employment activities while in high school have more employment success following graduation. Services include: Youth Extended Services, Counseling, Job Exploration, Job Shadowing, Work Based Learning

ASSESSMENT: COMMUNITY BASED WORK EVALUATION

Through a trial work period, an individual has the opportunity to experience work in a "real world" setting. Individuals work in a community business that closely aligns to their desired employment goal. This allows opportunities to learn about strengths, weaknesses and types of support that will lead to success in the work environment.

JOB/WORK READINESS TRAINING

Services are customized to fit the need of the individual or group. Services assist with identifying strengths, developing vocational goals, providing assistance in learning to complete pre-employment business and hiring paperwork. Topics also include: appropriate dress/hygiene, interview prep and how to disclose a disability, criminal background or ask for

an accommodation, transportation planning, GED support, and other individualized services for employment success.

JOB SEARCH ASSISTANCE

Our professional employment staff provides individualized job search assistance that leads to success in meeting the client's vocational goals in employment. Services include: assistance in completing applications, resumes and cover letters, learning how to talk to employers and schedule interviews and preparing for and attending interviews that lead to employment.

SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT JOB COACHING

For individuals that need extended or long term support on site, supported job coaching services are available.

WORK INCENTIVES PLANNING & ASSISTANCE
